
HOW TO FILE A NOISE COMPLAINT AT ST. PETE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

To access the noise complaint form from the fly2pie.com/noise-info website, scroll down to the "Track Flights at PIE" and select the "Flight Tracking" button.



The Noise Complaint Form is where you can enter the details of the complaint, including your contact details and time of noise event.



Once in the Flight Tracking Web Page - www.pie.airportpubportal.com, select the "File Noise Complaint" button on the top left of the map. This presents the Noise Complaint Form in Step 3




Once the required fields (marked with a Red *) are completed, your complaint can be filed. Please select the check box first, then press "SUBMIT". For details on each data element, press the "Accept the Terms and Conditions" to display a PDF with instructions on the complaint form



HOW TO REPLAY FLIGHT DATA

From the portal www.pie.airportpubportal.com, to replay data you will need to enter the start date and time for the replay. This is done in the date and time fields on the top left of the screen.



To enter the date, once you select the field, a calendar tool is presented allowing you to select the desired date.



UNDERSTANDING THE FLIGHT DATA



Each of the flights shows three data elements in addition to the location of the flight at that time.

- Flight ID The flight information as broadcast by the aircraft. (American Airlines 2150)
- Speed The speed of the aircraft as reported by the aircraft.
- Altitude This is the altitude of the aircraft at that moment. Add two 0's to the number for actual altitude (i.e. 50 = 5,000feet)
- To Identify the three letter Air Carrier Code: https://airlinecodes.info/icao/A

SPEED OF REPLAY



To control the speed of the replay, once the replay has started, select the replay speed value on the bottom left hand of the display

Once selected, a slider showing you different speeds will be expanded. Select the speed that you wish to replay from the list. The system will automatically start the replay at that speed from the start date/time selected.
