St. Petersburg-Clearwater International Airport notified Jetsgo Airlines ceased operations on March 11, 2005

The St. Petersburg-Clearwater International Airport received notification of Jetsgo Airlines closure on Friday, March 11, 2005. All arriving and departing flights on Jetsgo Airlines are cancelled effective immediately. Jetsgo's flight schedule at St. Petersburg-Clearwater International Airport during the current season included approximately 5-6 flights weekly to and from Toronto. Jetsgo's flight schedule throughout the weekend included one Friday, two Saturday and three Sunday flights.
