Located on the 1st floor of the terminal, the airport gift shop/newsstand and Duty Free Shop are all open at convenient hours in the terminal. The Duty Free Shop is located post security for departing passengers on international flights.



## Parking

Cash, credit and debit (Visa and Mastercard) are accepted for payment. Lots open 2 hours prior to first departure and 1 hour after the last arrival of the day.

Short-term: \$2 first hour, \$1 each additional 20 minutes, \$14 daily maximum

Long-term: \$2 first hour, \$1 each additional 20 minutes, \$11 daily maximum, \$77 weekly

Remote/Shuttle: \$8 per day (open only when long-term lot reaches capacity)

## Public Art & Exhibits

The airport is home to numerous works of art by a variety of renowned Florida artists. On the brochure cover is a detail of our new glass art wall designed by Guy Kemper.

In addition, two historical exhibits are featured in the terminal. PIE was previously a military training base until 1947. The General Howard Exhibit located adjacent to Ticketing B is a tribute to the last commander of the Pinellas Army Airfield, a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient for his service in World War II.

Tampa Bay also proudly claims the title of the birthplace of commercial aviation. In 1914, Tony Jannus piloted the first scheduled commercial flight from St. Petersburg to Tampa. A replica of the Benoist amphibious airplane flown on the inaugural flight along with a commemorative plaque is displayed in our baggage claim facility.
